Appetizer Competition Rules

To promote involvement from teams and the community, an Appetizer Competition will provide additional entertainment throughout the day of the event. Above all, we ask that each competitor remember that this event is a public event and all staff members are volunteers devoted to ensuring that this event is a successful event for all.

By entering into the steak cook-off, you have the option to participate in the appetizer competition. Participation in the appetizer contest is voluntary, but you must be in the steak competition to participate. There is no additional cost to enter this competition other than your steak team entry. The outcome of the appetizer contest carries no weight in the steak competition.

RULES

1. For this competition all appetizers and supplies must be brought by the competitor.
2. Appetizers should be single serving size and not an entire meal serving.
3. There is no limit to the type of appetizer that can be prepared except that it cannot be a ribeye steak.
4. The appetizer has to be prepared on site.
5. There is a limit of one appetizer per team.
6. They should be prepared and ready to taste between 2-3:30 PM.
7. The event will be judged as a people's choice award by ticketed voting from those in attendance.
8. Tickets will be \$1 per ticket and available at the check-in table.
9. The winner will be the team that receives the most tickets by the cutoff time of 3:30 PM.
10. Winners will be announced at 4:00 PM during the awards ceremony.
